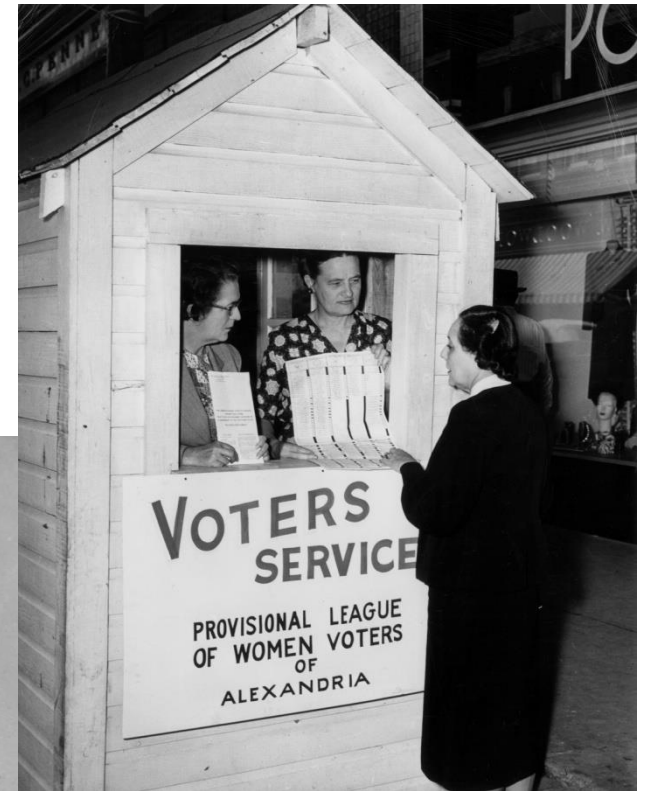

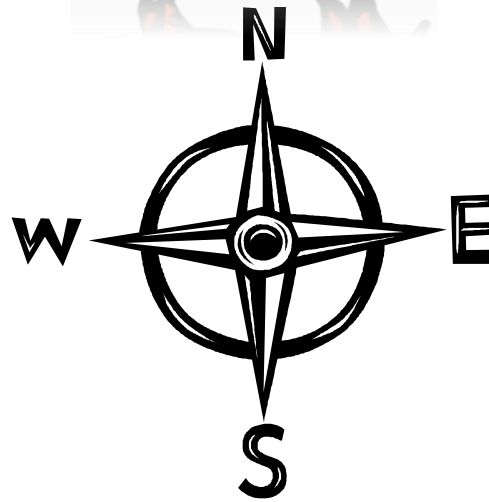
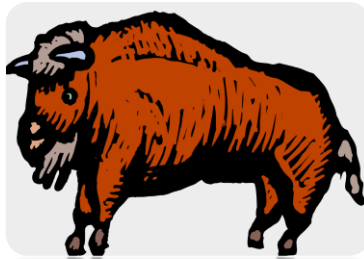
Change and Transition
